

In November Brianna's Hope celebrated it's 2nd Anniversary at St. Matthew United Methodist Church. Attendance has grown to

60 participants!

Brianna's Hope

Brianna's Hope mission project for Christmas is feeding the homeless on Christmas eve. We will be delivering food to the homeless shelter as well as feeding those at St. Matthew. We have partnered with Healthy Communities and are providing gifts to 25 homeless individuals. This includes a \$10.00 fast food gift card. St. Matthew is giving birth to a new ministry!

In the last year, Substance Use Disorder Peer Recovery Coaches at Healthy Communities have had over 200 recovery clients, over 750 people attended those recovery events. These events include Men's Recovery Cafes, Women's Recovery Cafes and Families Recovery Together.

The needs identified over the past couple months: Healthy Communities is very much in need of more facility space for these types of events. The community has identified the greatest need is a single location for recovery support and activities. Trinity United Methodist Church at 806 N Columbia recently closed and the building needs a new purpose. St. Matthew UMC congregation is looking to birth a new ministry and truly serve the community.

God's timing led us to a plan: The Trinity church property is being offered to St. Matthew by the Indiana Conference to become our property at no cost. Healthy Communities of Clinton County would love to partner with St. Matthew again. A very successful current partnership with them has been Brianna's Hope which now serves 40-60 people every week with programming to celebrate milestones in recovery.

HCCC would like to use the building for offices for the Peer Recovery Coaches and the Systems of Care Navigators to serve walk in clients. The recover events listed above would also take place in the building. They would compensate St. Matthew for the use and as part of the partnership would love to provide opportunities for our congregation members to serve our community. In addition, St. Matthew staff and members will plan programming for that neighborhood which could include vacation bible school, music programming and more.

The expected opening of the Trinity Hope Center supported by St. Matthew United Methodist Church is February or March. The name is perfect for the use but also in honor of the role both Trinity and Hope churches played in our community.
